God Bless America



**God Bless America** was written by Irving Berlin (real name Israel Baline) born in the village of Tyumen, in a harsh region of Russia known as Siberia. The Balines set out for America, when Irving was about five years old, because of an anti-Jewish mob destroyed his family home. Berlin described his goal for being a song writer as, "My ambition is to reach the heart of the average American." Kate Smith wanted a song to celebrate the end of World War 1. Berlin was not wanting to create a war song, but a song to celebrate America as a special place to live. Also, at that time, Adolf Hitler was growing in power. He remembered he wrote a song 20 years ago-God Bless America, a phrase his immigrant mother fervently repeated during Berlin's childhood. God has blessed America and our freedom comes at a high cost. Let us remember, "The best way to fight our battles is on our knees!"

**God reigns** over the nations; God is seated on His holy throne Psalm 47:8. We believe it is through the **grace** of our Lord Jesus that we are saved, just as they are Acts 15:11. For we did not follow closely devised stories when we told you about the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ in power but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty 2Peter 1:16 .
